ORDER

On November 15, 2010, IPGREALKY, LLC ("IPGREALKY") filed a formal complaint with the Commission against Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American"). By Order dated December 6, 2010, the Commission rejected IPGREALKY's because it was filed by an individual who is not licensed to practice law in Kentucky.¹ The Commission stated that IPGREALKY, by counsel, could re-file its complaint within 20 days. That time period has expired, and the Commission has not received any filings from IPGREALKY.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

¹ No person may engage in the practice of law in Kentucky without first obtaining a license to practice. SCR 2.100. The practice of law includes, as Kentucky's highest court held in <u>Kentucky State Bar Association v. Henry Vogt Machine Co.</u>, 416 S.W.2d 727 (Ky. 1967), the representation of a corporation before a state administrative agency.

2. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to prevent IPGREALKY, by counsel, from filing a complaint in the future. Any future complaint will be docketed as a new case.
