ORDER


On December 2, 2010, Navitas KY NG, LLC and Gasco Distribution Systems, ("Gasco") (collectively "Joint Applicants") filed an application requesting Inc. Commission approval of the transfer of ownership and control of Gasco's Albany, Kentucky, gas distribution system.

KRS 278.020(6) requires the Commission to render its final decision on the proposed transfer within 60 days of the filing of the application unless it is necessary, for good cause, to continue the application. If good cause for an extension exists, the Commission may extend the review period for an additional 60 days.

The Commission finds that it is necessary to follow-up on the Joint Applicants' responses to the Commission Staff's first data request prior to making a decision on this proposed transfer; therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to extend the 60-day period for decision set forth in KRS 278.020(6) for an additional 60 days. Notwithstanding our action this day, the Commission will endeavor to expedite the completion of our review.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the time in which the Commission shall render its decision on the Joint Applicants' request is extended an additional 60 days, pursuant to KRS 278.020(6).
