ORDER

Finding that Commission Staff requires additional time to complete its report on the application of South Shore Water Works Company ("South Shore") for a proposed rate adjustment and further finding that a procedural schedule should be established to allow for the orderly review of that application, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. No later than June 27, 2011, Commission Staff shall file with the Commission and serve upon all parties of record a report containing its findings and recommendations on South Shore's application.
- 2. The parties shall file with the Commission their written comments on and any objections to the findings and recommendations contained in the Commission Staff Report no later than July 11, 2011. Any party may file with such submission any additional evidence for the Commission's consideration.
- 3. A party's failure to file written objections to a finding or recommendation contained in the Staff Report by July 11, 2011 shall be deemed as agreement with that finding or recommendation.

- 4. No later July 11, 2011, each party shall notify the Commission in writing whether this matter may be submitted for decision based upon the existing record and without hearing.
- 5. Unless all parties request that this matter be submitted for decision upon the existing record, an informal conference shall be held in this matter on July 18, 2011 at 1:00 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard.
- 6. Unless all parties request that this matter be submitted for decision upon the existing record, a formal hearing in this matter shall be held in this matter in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky. The time and date of this hearing shall be established by later Order.
- 7. South Shore shall publish notice of the scheduled hearing in this matter in accordance with 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(5), and shall file proof of publication with the Commission no later than three business days before the scheduled hearing.
- 8. Each party shall be represented by an attorney who is licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 9. Each party shall be limited in its opening statement at the hearing in this matter to five minutes or less.
- 10. Each party shall file with the Commission, no later than July 22, 2011, a list of the persons it intends to call as witnesses at the scheduled hearing and a summary of each witness's expected testimony.

- 11. Any exhibits that a party wishes to introduce at hearing shall be marked with the party's name and a sequential number (e.g., South Shore Exhibit 1). References to a witness or type of examination are not necessary.
- 12. Unless the Commission directs otherwise, all parties shall file with the Commission responses to requests for information made at hearing no later than seven days following completion of the scheduled hearing.
- 13. Pursuant to KRS 278.360, the record of the formal hearing in this matter shall be by videotape.
- 14. Commission Staff shall make a written exhibit list and shall file this with the Commission along with all exhibits and a copy of the video transcript of the hearing.
