O R D E R

Pending before the Commission are two motions filed by Rick Clewett, Drew Foley, Janet Overman, Gregg Wagner, the Natural Resources Defense Council and the Sierra Club (collectively "Movants"). The first motion, filed on July 14, 2011, requests that the existing procedural schedule be revised to allow Movants an opportunity to issue supplemental data requests to Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") and Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and to also allow them to file their comments one month after receiving the KU and LG&E responses to the supplemental data requests. In support of this motion, Movants state that, as of the date that their intervention was granted, the dates for discovery had already passed, and although they had earlier served on KU and LG&E an initial data request, KU and LG&E refused to respond to that request until Movants' intervention had been granted.

In response to Movants' first motion, KU and LG&E state that, if the Commission authorizes the Movants to file supplemental data requests, the Commission should allow KU and LG&E 15 days to file responses to such requests. KU and LG&E further state that they have no objection to Movants' request to file comments 30 days after

receipt of responses to supplemental data requests, provided that KU and LG&E are afforded 15 days to file response comments.

Movants' second motion, filed August 8, 2011, requests the Commission to compel KU and LG&E to fully respond to Movants' initial data request, Item Nos. 7, 8, 9, and 10. On August 22, 2011, KU and LG&E responded to the motion to compel by stating that, on August 19, 2011, they filed supplemental responses to each item in the Movants' motion to compel and that those supplemental responses substantially, if not fully, respond to the request.

Based on the motions and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow Movants to issue a supplemental data request and to extend the time for filing comments to 30 days following the filing of responses to those requests by KU and LG&E. The Commission will also allow KU and LG&E 15 days thereafter to file response comments. With respect to the motion to compel, KU and LG&E have represented that their supplemental responses substantially, if not fully, answer the Items sought to be compelled. Since the Movants have filed nothing further to contradict the assertion by KU and LG&E that the motion has been satisfied, we will deny it as moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Movants' motion to file supplemental data requests and to file comments 30 days after receiving responses to those requests is granted.
2. Movants' motion to compel responses to Item Nos. 7, 8, 9, and 10 of their initial data request is denied as moot.

3. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall supersede all prior schedules and shall be followed from this date forward.
