
<u>O R D E R</u>

Pending before the Commission in these unconsolidated cases is a joint motion filed by Drew Foley, Janet Overman, Gregg Wagner, Rick Clewett, Raymond Barry, Sierra Club, and Natural Resources Defense Council (collectively "Movants") requesting an extension of time to file their direct testimony. Pursuant to the procedural schedule appended to the Commission's August 5, 2011 Order, intervenor testimony was due to be filed no later than September 16, 2011. Although the Movants indicated that their direct testimony was postmarked on Friday September 16, 2011, the Commission did not receive their direct testimony until Monday September 19, 2011. In support of their joint motion, the Movants state that they were under the mistaken assumption that they would be in compliance with the deadline for the filing of intervenor testimony as long as their direct testimony was postmarked by September 16, 2011. Accordingly, the Movants request a one-time extension of time to file their direct testimony on September 19, 2011 and commit to making sure that such error will not occur again.

Having reviewed the joint motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the Movants have established good cause to have an extension of time to file their direct testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Movants' joint motion for a one day extension of time to file their direct testimony is granted.
