ORDER

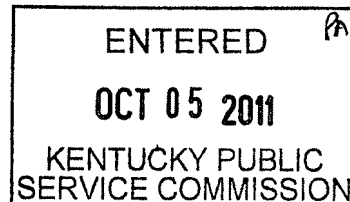
Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of its 32nd Annual Conference and Exhibition, which was held August 29-31, 2011 in Lexington, Kentucky, and at which instruction was provided on, *inter alia*, water quality laws, energy conservation, infrastructure replacement, rate regulation, personnel practices, legal responsibilities of water district commissioners, and wastewater treatment operations.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties."¹ Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the instruction in question will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 12.0 hours of water district management training.


