<u>ORDER</u>

Coolbrook Utilities, LLC ("Coolbrook") has moved for additional time in which to respond to Commission Staff's request for information. While the utility has failed to provide any specific reason for its inability to respond to the request in the time provided, the Commission finds that the utility should be afforded an additional ten days in which to prepare and submit its response and that the procedural schedule should be revised accordingly.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Coolbrook's Motion for Extension of Time is granted in part and denied in part.

2. Coolbrook shall file its responses to Commission Staff's First Request for Information with the Commission no later than February 13, 2012.

3. The procedural schedule set out in the Commission's Order of January 20, 2012 is vacated in its entirety and is replaced with the procedural schedule set forth in this Order.

4. No later than March 5, 2012, Commission Staff shall file with the Commission and serve upon all parties of record a report containing its findings and recommendations on Coolbrook's application.

5. The parties shall file with the Commission any written comments on and any objections to the findings and recommendations contained in the Commission Staff Report no later than March 19, 2012. Any party may file with such submission any additional evidence for the Commission's consideration.

6. A party's failure to file a written objection to a finding or recommendation contained in the Staff Report by March 19, 2012 shall be deemed as agreement with that finding or recommendation.


7. Each party shall file with the Commission, no later than March 26, 2012, a list of the witnesses that it intends to call at the scheduled hearing and a summary of each witness's expected testimony.

8. A formal hearing shall be held in this matter beginning at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, on April 3, 2012 at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

9. Coolbrook shall publish notice of the scheduled hearing in accordance with 807 KAR 5:076, Section 11.

10. Pursuant to KRS 278.360, the record of the formal hearing in this matter shall be by videotape.
