ORDER

On April 9, 2012, Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") made a tariff filing seeking Commission approval of demand-side management ("DSM") programs. Kenergy's proposed tariffs are designated as PSC No. 2, Sheets 47 through 54A, and Kenergy has proposed that its new DSM programs become effective on April 30, 2012.

Based on the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that an investigation of the proposed DSM programs is necessary to determine their reasonableness and that such investigation cannot be concluded prior to the effective date. Consequently, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed DSM programs for one day and allow them to become effective subject to change prospectively.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kenergy's proposed DSM programs are suspended for the one day of April 30, 2012, and shall become effective on May 1, 2012 subject to change prospectively.
