COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
TO KENERGY CORP.

Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and six copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within seven days of the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.


Kenergy shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Kenergy fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall

provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond. Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

1. Refer to Kenergy's proposed tariff, pages 55 and 56, the Residential Weather Normalization tariffs. The Member Incentive sections of these pages state that Kenergy will provide a certain percentage of the cost of weatherization improvements and the Terms and Conditions section states that Kenergy will contract with a third-party contractor that performs weatherization projects, pay the contractor \$150 for the initial audit, and pay \$3 per installed CFL bulb and \$10 per installed low-flow aerator and/or shower head. However, in the Residential Weatherization Program tariffs filed by Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers"),¹ Kenergy's wholesale supplier, it states that Big Rivers will provide a certain percentage of the cost of weatherization improvements and that Big Rivers will contract with a third-party contractor that performs weatherization projects, pay the contractor \$150 for the initial audit, and pay \$3 per installed CFL bulb and \$10 per installed low-flow aerator and/or shower head. State which entity is responsible for the items listed. If the responsible party is Big Rivers, provide revised tariff pages 55, 55A, 56, and 56A.
