COMMISSION STAFF'S THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO
MEADE COUNTY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE CORPORATION


Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Meade"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and six copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due within seven days of the date of this request. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Meade shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though

correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Meade fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond. Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

1. Refer to Meade's proposed Residential Weatherization Programs, Schedules 30 and 35. Under the Terms and Conditions section of each schedule, paragraph 5 states that Big Rivers Electric Corporation, Meade's wholesale supplier, will pay \$10 per installed low-flow aerator, or low-flow shower head. In Case No. 2012-00143¹, Kenergy Corp. has added language to its proposed Residential Weather Normalization programs limiting the \$10 payment to only when an electric water heater is in use. Does Meade intend to impose the same limitation? If yes, provide revised pages for Schedules 30 and 35 reflecting this limitation. If no, explain the reasons for not imposing the limitation.
