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## <u>ORDER</u>

On August 27, 2012, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed a petition, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, for leave to deviate from the filing requirements with respect to its August 27, 2012 Supplemental Response ("Supplemental Response") to Item 1 of the First Set of Data Requests of Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. The Commission's Order of June 28, 2012 requires Kentucky Power to file an original and ten copies of its response.

In support of its August 27, 2012 petition, Kentucky Power states that the supporting documentation for its August 27, 2012 Supplemental Response is 773 pages and that producing an original response along with a paper copy to the party of record and ten paper copies to the Commission is unduly burdensome.

Kentucky Power requests leave to deviate from the Commission's June 28, 2012 Order by filing a paper "original" with the Commission, serving paper copies on the party of record, and submitting ten electronic copies to the Commission. Based on the petition and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power has established good cause to deviate from the requirement that it file ten paper copies with the Commission and that its petition should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky Power's petition to deviate from the filing requirements of the Commission's June 28, 2012 Order is granted.

2. Kentucky Power shall file an original paper copy with the Commission, serve paper copies on the party of record, and submit ten electronic copies to the Commission.

3. Kentucky Power shall file within seven days of the date of this Order the paper original with the Commission.
