<u>ORDER</u>

On December 29, 2009, in Case No. 2009-00202,¹ the Commission approved rates for Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Duke's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On June 8, 2012, Duke filed its GCA to be effective June 29, 2012.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Duke's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.

2. Duke's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$4.653 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.035 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$4.618 per Mcf.

3. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Refund Adjustment ("RA") of (\$.001) per Mcf. Duke's total RA is (\$.004) per Mcf, which represents no change from its previous total RA.

4. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Actual Adjustment ("AA") of (\$.233) per Mcf. Duke's total AA is (\$.329) per Mcf, which represents no change from its previous total AA.

5. Duke's notice sets out its current quarter Balancing Adjustment ("BA") of \$.055 per Mcf. Duke's total BA of \$.048 per Mcf represents no change from its previous total BA.

6. Duke's Gas Cost Recovery ("GCR") rate is \$4.368 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.035 per Mcf from its previous GCR of \$4.333 per Mcf.

7. The rates as proposed by Duke and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for final meter readings by Duke on and after June 29, 2012.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Duke and set forth in the Appendix to this Order are approved for final meter readings on and after June 29, 2012.

2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Duke shall file its revised tariffs with this Commission setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
