ORDER

On June 19, 2012, Leslie County Telephone Company, Lewisport Telephone Company, Salem Telephone Company (collectively "TDS Telecom"), New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility ("AT&T Mobility"), and Cincinnati SMSA Limited Partnership ("Cincinnati SMSA") filed with the Commission an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between TDS Telcom, AT&T Mobility, and Cincinnati SMSA. The amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252.

The Commission has reviewed the amendment and finds that no portion of the amendment discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the amendment.
