## COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and six copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before March 29, 2013. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

KU shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when

made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which KU fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, KU shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond. Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

- 1. Refer to KU's response to Item 1 of the Commission's February 13, 2013 Request for Information ("February 13, 2013 Request"). State whether the proposed per-unit fuel cost of \$.02892 is representative of current fuel costs.
- 2. Refer to KU's response to Item 40 of the February 13, 2013 Request. The response states that "KU has identified an issue with the reported energy in the monthly FAC filings for the expense months of April 2012 through January 2013 that will need to be corrected in a future monthly FAC filing." Explain fully the issue referred to in this response, its effect on the period under review, and how it will be corrected.
