<u>ORDER</u>


On March 14, 2013, the Commission on its own motion initiated an investigation of whether Irvington Gas Company's ("Irvington Gas") underground propane operation should be classified as a utility under the jurisdiction of the Commission. On April 24, 2013, Irvington Gas filed its response to the Commission's Order initiating this investigation. On May 7, 2013, Irvington Gas representatives met with Commission Staff at an informal conference and a memorandum of this conference was filed June 14, 2013. No response to that memorandum was filed by Irvington Gas. There are no intervenors in this case. At this time, the Commission finds that there is sufficient information in the record to adjudicate the issue of jurisdiction and that, unless otherwise requested, a hearing will not be required in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Irvington Gas shall have ten days from the date of this Order to request a hearing.

2. Unless a hearing is requested, this matter shall stand submitted on the record.
