ORDER

On May 15, 2013, Appalachian Waste Control, Inc. applied for approval of the transfer of control and ownership of its Neal Price Estates Subdivision Wastewater Treatment Plant.¹ KRS 278.020(6) requires the Commission to render a final decision on the proposed transfer within 60 days of the filing of the application unless it is necessary, for good cause shown, to continue the application. If good cause exists, the Commission may extend the review period for an additional 60 days.

Finding that additional time to review the record is required before a final decision can be rendered in this matter and that good cause exists to extend the review period, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that the period for reviewing the proposed transfer is extended to 120 days.
