ORDER

On October 3, 2013, an informal conference was conducted for the purpose of addressing the request of the Attorney General ("AG"), Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc., and Sierra Club (collectively "Intervenors") to revise the current procedural schedule as established pursuant to the Commission's July 18, 2013 Order. Pointing to the fact that the hearing for this case is scheduled to begin on January 7, 2014, Intervenors request that the remaining outstanding deadlines in the procedural schedule be extended in order to allow the parties in this matter additional time to file their respective testimonies.
