ORDER

On June 5, 2013, Madison County Utilities District ("Madison County") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Madison County purchases water from the city of Richmond ("Richmond").
- 2. On July 1, 2013, Richmond increased its volumetric wholesale rate to Madison County from \$2.3001 per 100 cubic feet to \$2.40603 per 100 cubic feet.²
- 3. Madison County proposes to place its adjusted rates into effect July 1, 2013.
- 4. Madison County proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.13 per 100 cubic feet.
- 5. During the 12 months ending April 30, 2013, Madison County purchased 91,459,915 cubic feet of water from Richmond and sold 75,692,091 cubic feet of water.

Richmond's wholesale rate included the base rate of \$2.23510 per 100 cubic feet plus the Kentucky River Authority Fee of \$0.065 per 100 cubic feet. Its current rate has a base component of \$2.28203 per 100 cubic feet and a Kentucky River Authority Fee component of \$0.124 per 100 cubic feet. See TFS 2013-00346 (filed May 3, 2013); Letter from Dennis Brent Kirtley, Manager, Public Service Commission, to Scott Althauser, General Manager, Richmond Utilities (June 18, 2013).

The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$96,883.49, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.13 per 100 cubic feet.

- 6. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.13 per 100 cubic feet, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
- 7. The rates set forth in Appendix B are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for service that Madison County renders on and after July 1, 2013.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.13 per 100 cubic feet is approved.
- 2. Madison County's proposed rates, which are set forth in Appendix B, are approved for services rendered on or after July 1, 2013.
- 3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Madison County shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein, with an effective date of July 1, 2013.
