ORDER

On August 21, 2013, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") tendered an application seeking authority for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the modification of its air pollution control system at the company's Cooper Generating Station, for approval of an Amended Environmental Surcharge Compliance Plan ("Amended Plan") and a revised Environmental Surcharge to recover the costs of the Amended Plan.

Having reviewed EKPC's application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the Cooper Station alterations and the proposed amendment of the previously approved environmental compliance plan.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.

2. a. All requests for information and responses thereto shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed, and the original and ten copies shall be filed with the Commission, with copies to all parties of record. Any request for information from the Commission Staff shall be responded to as if set forth in a Commission Order. All responses shall include the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions related to the information provided.

b. Each response shall be answered under oath, or for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or an association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

c. A party shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made, or though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect.

d. For any request to which a party fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, that party shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

3. Any party filing testimony shall file with the Commission an original and ten copies.

4. EKPC shall give notice of the hearing in accordance with the provisions set out in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). At the time publication is requested, EKPC shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

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
5. A person who submits a motion to intervene after September 27, 2013, and upon a showing of good cause is granted leave to intervene, shall accept and abide by the existing procedural schedule.

6. At any public hearing in this matter, neither opening statements nor summarization of direct testimonies shall be permitted.

7. Motions for extensions of time with respect to the schedule herein shall be made in writing and will be granted only upon a showing of good cause.

8. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
