## ORDER

On September 3, 2013, Henry County Water District No. 2 ("Henry District") tendered to the Commission its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity and for authority to issue certain evidences of indebtedness. In this application, Henry District requests a deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), which requires the filing of a financial exhibit covering "operations for a twelve (12) month period . . . ending not more than ninety (90) days prior to the date the application is filed." Henry District has provided its financial statements for calendar year 2012 and represents that there has been no change that is material in nature in its financial condition or operation since the publication of these statements.

Finding that Henry District has demonstrated good cause to permit its deviation from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

- 1. Henry District's request to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 17(2)(a), is granted.
  - 2. Henry District's application is considered filed as of the date of this Order.

3. Nothing contained in this Order shall preclude the Commission from requiring the production of information regarding Henry District's financial condition or operations since December 31, 2012.
