## ORDER

On September 4, 2013, Purchase Public Service Corporation and Paducah-McCracken County Joint Sewer Agency ("JSA") (collectively "Joint Applicants") applied for Commission approval of the transfer of ownership and control of Blandville West Subdivision Wastewater Treatment Facilities to JSA. KRS 278.020(6) provides that the Commission approve or deny such application within 60 days of its filing unless it is necessary, for good cause, to extend the application for an additional 60 days. Accordingly, the Commission must no later than November 2, 2013, issue a final decision on the application or continue the matter.

The Joint Applicants have recently provided responses to a Commission Staff request for information concerning the proposed transfer. Finding that additional time is necessary to review these responses and to evaluate the proposed transfer, that our review of the application cannot be completed by November 2, 2013, and that good cause therefore exists to extend the review period, the Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that the application is continued for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of this Order.
