ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of three regional meetings that will be held in October 2013 at which instruction will be provided on supervisory control and data acquisition systems, ice pigging, the reduction of disinfection by-products in water distribution systems, and successful water utility organization practices.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties." Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the instruction in question would enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 2.0 hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's instruction at its regional meeting on October 15, 2013, in Morehead, Kentucky, (WT 2013-020) is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.

- 2. KRWA's instruction at its regional meeting on October 17, 2013, in Owensboro, Kentucky, (WT 2013-021) is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.
- 3. KRWA's instruction at its regional meeting on October 24, 2013, in Draffenville, Kentucky, (WT 2013-022) is accredited and approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours of water district management training.
- 4. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentation.
- 5. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, KRWA shall file with the Commission:
- a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;
- b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and
- c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
