ORDER

On October 31, 2008, in Case No. 2008-00032,¹ the Commission approved rates for Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. ("Burkesville") and provided for their further adjustment on a monthly basis in accordance with Burkesville's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause. On June 1, 2013, Burkesville implemented a revision in its GCA clause to provide for quarterly adjustment of its rates.

On February 3, 2014, Burkesville filed an interim GCA with a proposed effective date of March 6, 2014. Burkesville explained in its cover letter that its gas supplier had advised that prices for February and March gas deliveries will be much more than previously expected, necessitating the interim adjustment.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

1. Burkesville's notice includes revised rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in gas costs.
2. Burkesville's proposed EGC is \$9.8930 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$1.5444 per Mcf from the prior EGC of \$8.3486 per Mcf.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers served by
Burkesville Gas Company, Inc. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned
herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of the Commission prior
to the effective date of this Order.

3. Burkesville's notice sets out no Refund Adjustment.

4. Burkesville's notice sets out its current Actual Adjustment ("AA") of \$.0146 per Mcf. Burkesville's total AA is \$.1087 per Mcf, which reflects the expiration of a previous AA of \$.0866. Burkesville's total AA represents a decrease of \$.0866 per Mcf from the previous total AA of \$.1953 per Mcf.

5. Burkesville's GCA is \$10.0017 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$1.4578 per Mcf from the previous GCA of \$8.5439 per Mcf.

6. The rates in the Appendix to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable, and should be approved for service rendered by Burkesville on and after March 6, 2014.

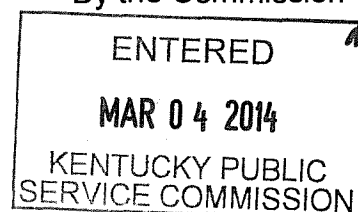
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Burkesville's request to implement an interim GCA is approved.


2. The rates in the Appendix, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are approved for service rendered on and after March 6, 2014.
