ORDER

On March 25, 2014, the Commission accepted for filing Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District's ("Jessamine") application for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the treated sewage adjustment procedure.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("LFUCG") agreed by contract dated January 3, 2003, to treat sewage transmitted from Jessamine. The contract allows sewer user fees to be calculated based upon the monthly water usage of all sewer service customers.

2. On April 1, 2014, LFUCG increased its wholesale sewage treatment rate to Jessamine from \$4.51 per 100 cubic feet to \$4.56 per 100 cubic feet.<sup>2</sup> Jessamine proposes to increase the sewage rates to its customers effective April 1, 2014.

3. During the 12 months ending January 31, 2014, Jessamine reported 5,532,098 cubic feet of water consumption (41,490,735 gallons) for its sewer

customers. The increase in the cost of treated sewer is \$2,766.05, resulting in a treated sewer adjustment of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons.

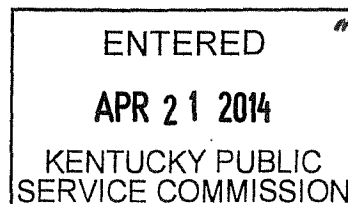
4. The treated sewer adjustment of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

5. Jessamine's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered on and after April 1, 2014.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The treated sewer adjustment of \$0.07 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
2. Jessamine's proposed rates are approved for sewer service rendered on and after April 1, 2014.
3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Jessamine shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
