ORDER

On March 31, 2014, the Commission issued an Order to commence an investigation into the request of R. A. Williams Development Co. d/b/a Cedarbrook Wastewater Treatment Plant ("Cedarbrook") to shut down and abandon its utility facilities. The Order required Cedarbrook to respond to the request for information set forth in Appendix B by April 14, 2014. On April 14, 2014, Cedarbrook moved the Commission for a 60-day extension to the original due date for filing its responses to the request for information. In support, Cedarbrook states it does not have sufficient staff to assemble the required information within the requisite time.

The Commission, having considered Cedarbrook's motion, finds that good cause exists to grant a 60-day extension of time within which to respond to the request for information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Cedarbrook's motion for an extension of time is granted.
2. Cedarbrook shall respond to the request for information in Appendix B to the Commission's March 31, 2014 Order by June 13, 2014.

3. Cedarbrook shall continue to operate its utility facilities during the pendency of this matter and until the Commission issues an Order authorizing Cedarbrook's request to abandon its facilities.
