ORDER


On June 10, 2014, Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Taylor RECC") submitted an application for approval of an Economic Development Rider. On June 30, 2014, the Commission issued an initial request for information to Taylor RECC and directed responses to be filed by July 14, 2014. Thereafter, on July 10, 2014, Taylor RECC moved the Commission for a ten-day extension of time to file its responses to the request for information. In support, Taylor RECC states that staff members necessary to prepare responses to the information requests have been otherwise engaged with preparing for its July 11, 2014 annual meeting, election of directors, and vacations. Accordingly, Taylor RECC states that compiling the information absent a ten-day extension would create a hardship on the utility and staff.

The Commission, having considered Taylor RECC's motion, finds that good cause exists to grant a ten-day extension of time for it to respond to the request for information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Taylor RECC's motion for an extension of time is granted.
2. Taylor RECC shall respond to Commission Staff's June 30, 2014 Initial Request for Information no later than July 24, 2014.
