## <u>ORDER</u>

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation and approval of its Water Loss Management Training, which will be held at three separate times and locations: July 15, 2014, in Morehead, Kentucky; July 17, 2014, in Owensboro, Kentucky; and July 24, 2014, in Draffenville, Kentucky. This conference provides instruction on managing water loss in drinking water utilities, specifically through: (1) water audits; (2) leak detection; (3) meter testing; and (4) other methods.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties."<sup>1</sup> Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the conference's presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for two hours of water district management training for attendance of a single session.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's Water Loss Management Training, which will be held on

July 15, 2014, in Morehead, Kentucky; July 17, 2014, in Owensboro, Kentucky; and July 24, 2014, in Draffenville, Kentucky, is accredited and approved for a maximum of two credit hours of water district management training.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentation.


3. No later than September 15, 2014, KRWA shall file with the Commission:

a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;

b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and

c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
