ORDER

On July 17, 2014, Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Shelby Energy") filed an application seeking approval of changes in the certified territories of Shelby Energy and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") pursuant to KRS 278.018(6) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14. On September 3, 2014, Commission Staff issued its First Request for Information ("Staff's First Request") to Shelby Energy. Shelby Energy was required to file responses to those discovery requests by September 17, 2014.


On September 16, 2014, Shelby Energy submitted a motion for a ten-day extension of time within which Shelby Energy may respond to Staff's First Request. As a basis for its motion, Shelby Energy states that it will need additional time to obtain and review the Certified Territory Map for the Simpsonville Quadrangle referenced in Item 2 of Staff's First Request. Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Shelby Energy has demonstrated good cause for an extension of time to respond to Staff's First Request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Shelby Energy's motion for an extension of time is granted.

2. Shelby Energy shall submit its response to Staff's First Request for Information on or before September 29, 2014.
