ORDER

The matter is before the Commission upon a motion filed by East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") requesting leave to file the supplemental direct testimony of Don Mosier. Mr. Mosier's supplemental testimony was attached to EKPC's motion. In support of its motion, EKPC states that it has been requested by PJM Interconnection, LLC ("PJM"), a regional transmission organization of which EKPC is a member, to seek a one-year extension for Dale Station Units 3 and 4 for complying with the Mercury and Air Toxics Standards ("MATS") rule rather than indefinitely idling those two units as EKPC had originally intended. EKPC advises that PJM has expressed concerns regarding available capacity resources for the 2015/2016 Delivery Year and the adequacy of available resources to maintain the reliability of the regional bulk power system that PJM operates. After consulting with PJM and conducting its own internal analysis, EKPC has decided to assist PJM and will seek a one-year extension for Dale


Station Units 3 and 4 for complying with the MATS rule. Accordingly, EKPC requests leave to supplement Mr. Mosier's direct testimony so that the record accurately reflects the developments discussed in the motion.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that EKPC has established good cause to permit it to file the supplemental direct testimony of Don Mosier. The Commission further finds that a limited procedural schedule should be established regarding the supplemental testimony of Mr. Mosier.

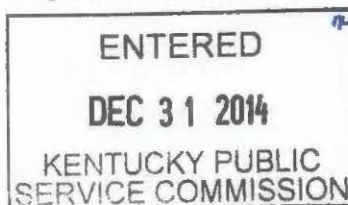
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

3. All requests for information to EKPC regarding the supplemental direct testimony of Don Mosier shall be filed no later than January 14, 2015.
4. EKPC shall file responses to requests for information regarding the supplemental direct testimony of Don Mosier no later than January 23, 2015.
5. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
