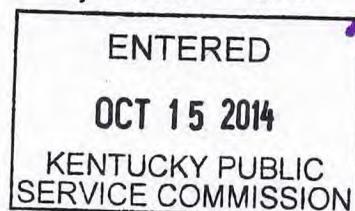

ORDER

At the request of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. ("Duke"), an informal conference was held at the Commission's offices on September 25, 2014. As memorialized in a September 25, 2014 memorandum, Duke and Commission Staff reached an agreement in principle with Duke which, if accepted by the Commission, would resolve all issues in this matter.<sup>1</sup> The memorandum also states that to provide sufficient time for the agreement to be drafted, signed, and submitted for consideration by the Commission, Duke agreed that the hearing in this matter currently scheduled for October 29, 2014, should be indefinitely suspended.

In consideration of the settlement in principle, and finding good cause, the Commission, HEREBY ORDERS that the hearing currently scheduled in this case for October 29, 2014, is indefinitely suspended to a date to be determined if needed.
