ORDER

On April 14, 2015, Kentucky-American Water Company ("KAWC") advised the Commission of its acceptance of the amount of the revenue increase set forth in the Commission Staff Report ("Staff Report") issued March 31, 2015, but requested that the increase be implemented with annual rate changes over a four-year period instead of a two-year period for the purposes of gradualism.

KAWC requests that the Informal Conference scheduled for April 28, 2015, be cancelled, that a hearing not be held, and the matter be submitted on the record.

KAWC further requests that it not be required to file a tariff for its sewer division at this time. KAWC indicates it is in the process of revising its tariff for the water division and intends to present both the sewer and water divisions' revised tariffs to the Commission prior to the end of 2015.

Having reviewed KAWC's April 14, 2015 Comments to the Staff Report and all other relevant information, the Commission finds that:

1. KAWC has filed an annual report for its sewer division since 1998.1

- KAWC has never filed a separate tariff for its sewer utility as required by 807 KAR 5:011, Section 2(3).
- 3. Within 20 days of entry of the Final Order in this case, KAWC should file a tariff for its sewer division through the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System.
- 4. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, KAWC should publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice should be in the format set forth in the Appendix to this Order.
- 5. KAWC should provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than May 25, 2015.
- 6. Any motion to intervene based on KAWC's acceptance of the revenue requirement proposed in the Staff Report should be filed no later than June 8, 2015.
 - 7. The April 28, 2015 informal conference should be cancelled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Within 20 days of entry of the Final Order in this case, KAWC shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, a revised tariff sheet setting out the rates approved for its sewer division.
- 2. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, KAWC shall publish a one-time notice following the requirements of 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5. The customer notice shall be in the format set forth in the Appendix to this Order.
- 3. KAWC shall provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than May 25, 2015.
- 4. Any motion to intervene based on KAWC's acceptance of the revenue requirements proposed in the Staff Report shall be filed no later than June 8, 2015.

5. The April 28, 2015 informal conference is cancelled.

NOTICE

On December 9, 2014, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") accepted for filing Kentucky-American Water Company's ("Kentucky-American") application requesting to increase its sewer service revenues by approximately 21% to be implemented over two phases. After performing a review of Kentucky-American's application and records, the PSC Staff recommended that Kentucky-American be granted an increase in sewer service revenues of approximately 62%. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of March 31, 2015, in Case No. 2014-00390, Kentucky-American requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff recommended revenue requirement and that Kentucky-American be allowed to implement the revised rates over a four-year period as follows:
