Black Mountain also indicated that it waives its right to a hearing and that this matter should be submitted for a decision based upon the existing record.


The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Within 14 days of the date of this Order, Black Mountain shall notify its customers of the implementation of the proposed rates by publishing notice of the increase in a newspaper of general circulation in its territory or placing an insert in bills rendered to its customers. The customer notice shall be in the format set forth in the Appendix to this Order.

2. Black Mountain shall provide proof of publication of the notice to the Commission no later than 30 days from the date of this Order.

3. If the Commission does not receive any written requests for intervention or a hearing in this matter within 30 days of publication of new rates, this case shall stand submitted to the Commission for decision based upon the existing record.

# NOTICE TO THE CUSTOMERS OF BLACK MOUNTAIN UTILITY DISTRICT

On May 6, 2015, Black Mountain Utility District ("Black Mountain") applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") for authority to adjust its rates for water service. The initial proposed effective date of the requested rate adjustment was made pursuant to the date of an Order granting an increase by the PSC. After performing a review of Black Mountain's application and records, the PSC Staff has recommended to the PSC that Black Mountain adjust its rates to their retail customers that are different from those proposed by Black Mountain. The tables below reflect the present retail rates and the retail rates proposed by the PSC Staff:

The monthly water bill for the average retail customer using 4,200 gallons of water monthly will increase from \$38.30 to \$47.96, or 25.22%, for the former Water Rate A customers; from \$31.48 to \$47.96, or 52.35%, for the former Water Rate D customers; and from \$44.16 to \$43.70, or -1.04%, for the former Green Hills customers.
