ORDER

On December 11, 2015, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively "LG&E/KU") filed with the Commission an application for approval of the extension of the School Energy Management Program and the associated cost recovery and tariffs. The application proposes that the tariffs become effective on January 10, 2016. Based upon our initial review, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and that the investigation cannot be completed by January 10, 2016. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the effective date of the proposed tariffs for five months.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- LG&E/KU's proposed tariffs are suspended for five months from January
 2016, up to and including June 9, 2016.
- Nothing shall prevent the Commission from issuing further Orders in this matter.
