ORDER

The Commission, on its own motion, finds that Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") should present as a witness its President and Chief Executive Officer, Jeff Hohn, at the hearing scheduled for this matter on May 10, 2016, to testify on measures that Kenergy has taken and will undertake to manage its costs and improve operational efficiencies. The Commission recognizes that Mr. Hohn has been employed with Kenergy only since October 2015, and did not file prepared testimony, but we find that cases of this nature should be supported by the testimony of the applicant's top executive. However, in light of Mr. Hohn's recent employment at Kenergy, we will limit his testimony to the topics described above.

The Commission also, on its own motion, finds that a letter dated April 29, 2016, from Kenergy to Commission staff counsel concerning the status of Kenergy's implementation of an advanced metering infrastructure system and proposing a methodology regarding the elimination of a 20-day billing lag and the resulting impact on members' bills should be entered into the record of this case. Kenergy's April 29, 2016 letter is attached hereto as the Appendix. To the extent that Kenergy's proposed methodology may have an impact on revenues and/or customers' bills, Kenergy should

present a witness at the May 10, 2016 hearing who is knowledgeable on the issues and able to address questions that may be asked.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- Kenergy shall present Jeff Hohn as a witness at the hearing scheduled for this matter on May 10, 2016, for the purpose of providing testimony on behalf of Kenergy as described in the findings above.
- Kenergy's April 29, 2016 letter is filed in and made a part of the official record of this case.
- Kenergy shall make a witness available at the May 10, 2016 Hearing to testify on the issues presented in its April 29, 2016 letter.

Dear Quang:

Kenergy's installation of automated meters is nearly complete and the system will soon be activated. This system will provide Kenergy with real time usage information enabling more current billing of energy. This in turn eliminates the billing lag that resulted from member read meters. Simply, we no longer have to wait for the member to submit his meter reading. However, the billing lag that has resulted from member read meters is 20 days and Kenergy does not desire to impose an extra 20 days of usage on the member's bill at once.

Kenergy appears to be the only cooperative to have gone from member read meters to automated meters. We believe other cooperatives have eliminated the billing lag through their intermediary contract meter readers. We can find no PSC authority discussing the proper methodology for eliminating the billing lag.

Part of our cost justification for AMI was eliminating the billing lag caused by the lengthy period that members were given to turn their own readings in. Essentially, Kenergy will be turning the billing lag into cash. The cushion of credit rate of return on the billing lag cash is substantial.

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Because of a lack of precedent, we are submitting this to the PSC for its review and direction to Kenergy for any action beyond this notification.

We look forward to hearing from you and if further information is needed, please advise.
