### ORDER

By Order entered February 10, 2017, the Commission established a procedural schedule for this case. Pursuant to the schedule, the response of Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Shelby Energy") to Commission Staff's Second Request for Information ("Staff's Second Request") was due on March 17, 2017. On March 16, 2017, Shelby Energy filed a motion for an extension of this deadline to and including March 24, 2017. In support of its motion, Shelby Energy states that it is a small cooperative with a limited office staff, and that in light of the volume of data involved with Staff's Second Request, an extension of time is needed to avoid a potentially significant disruption of Shelby Energy's operations and to ensure the accuracy of its responses.

The Commission, having considered Shelby Energy's motion, finds that good cause exists to grant Shelby Energy an extension of time in which to file its response to Staff's Second Request. The Commission further finds that the previously established procedural schedule should be amended and revised to reflect the lack of intervenors.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Shelby Energy's motion for an extension of time is granted.
- 2. The amended procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be followed.
