## ORDER

On February 24, 2017, Henderson County Water District ("Henderson County") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. ${ }^{1}$

The Commission notes that in its 2015 Annual Report Henderson County reported a water loss of 24.6194 percent. ${ }^{2}$ Henderson County's application provides updated purchases and sales information for a more current period than the 2015 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066(6)(3) states that for rate making purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed fifteen (15) percent of total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the updated information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2015 Annual Report, ${ }^{3}$ Henderson County's

[^0]unaccounted-for water loss is determined to be 22.62 percent for the updated period. ${ }^{4}$ Reduction of Henderson County's unaccounted-for water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate $\$ 90,456.05^{5}$ decrease to purchased water expense. Potentially, Henderson County is paying $\$ 0.2678$ per 1,000 gallons sold for expenses associated with unaccounted-for water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent $^{6}$ threshold.

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the fifteen (15) percent unaccounted-for water loss threshold and strongly encourages Henderson County to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss. Failure by Henderson County to make significant process towards reducing unaccounted-for water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

[^1]The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Henderson County purchases water from the Henderson Water Utility ("Henderson"). Henderson provides water to Henderson County in two separate areas, Henderson Water Utility North ("Henderson-North") and Henderson Water Utility South ("Henderson-South").
2. Henderson notified Henderson County on December 16, 2016, its wholesale rate to Henderson County for Henderson-North would increase from \$2.4507 per 1,000 gallons to $\$ 2.7319$ per 1,000 gallons and its wholesale rate for HendersonSouth would increase from $\$ 2.2745$ per 1,000 gallons to $\$ 2.3638$ per 1,000 gallons, effective on April 1, 2017. ${ }^{7}$ Henderson County proposed to increase the water rates to its customers effective April 1, 2017, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Henderson.
3. Henderson County proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.39$ per 1,000 gallons. Henderson County's application contained a typographical error in the Henderson-South rate. The application stated the rate for Henderson-South purchases will increase to $\$ 2.6368$ per 1,000 gallons; however, the Henderson-South rate that will become effective on April 1,2017 will only increase to $\$ 2.3638$ per 1,000 gallons.
4. During the 12 months ended December 31, 2016, Henderson County purchased $379,405,003$ gallons of water from Henderson-North and 64,011,918 from
[^2]Henderson-South and sold $337,771,166$ gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is $\$ 112,404.95$, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.34 per 1,000 gallons.
5. The purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.34$ per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, permits Henderson County to pass through the increase in its wholesale rates from Henderson and is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
6. Henderson County's proposed rates, which, due to a typographical error, overstate the amount of the purchased water adjustment necessary for Henderson Country to pass through the increase in its wholesale rates from Henderson, should be denied.
7. The rates as set forth in Appendix $B$ to this Order are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Henderson County on and after April 1, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of $\$ 0.34$ per 1,000 gallons is approved.
2. Henderson County's proposed rates are denied.
3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Henderson County on and after April 1, 2017.
4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Henderson County shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
