#### <u>ORDER</u>

On February 20, 2015, Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) filed a motion requesting confidential treatment for its response to Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Supplemental Request for Information (LFUCG's Supplemental Request), Item 2, for an indefinite period. The designated materials consist of contracts for the use of street lighting for non-lighting purposes. KU states that each contract contains express provisions requiring the terms and conditions of the contracts to be kept confidential.

Having carefully considered the motion and the materials at issue, the Commission finds that KU's response to LFUCG's Supplemental Request, Item 2 satisfies the requirements of KRS 61.878(1)(c), which excludes from public disclosure materials generally recognized as confidential, and therefore KU's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KU's motion for confidential protection of its responses to LFUCG's Supplemental Request, Item 2, is granted.

2. The designated materials shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for an indefinite period, or until further Order of the Commission.


3. Use of the materials in question in any Commission proceeding shall be in compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13(9).

4. KU shall inform the Commission if the materials in question become publicly available or no longer qualify for confidential treatment.

5. If a non-party to this proceeding requests to inspect materials granted confidential treatment by this Order, KU shall have 20 days from receipt of written notice of the request to demonstrate that the materials still fall within the exclusions from disclosure requirements established in KRS 61.878. If KU is unable to make such demonstration, the requested materials shall be made available for inspection.
