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ORDER

On November 16, 2018, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) a motion requesting to cancel the November 27, 2018 hearing in this matter and to dismiss this proceeding without prejudice. The instant matter is a partial rehearing of the Commission's March 16, 2018 Order denying a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) for a Supplemental Project consisting of improvements to the Hazard and Wooton substations based upon the Commission's finding that Kentucky Power failed to meet its burden of proof regarding the need for the Supplemental Project.

As a basis for its motion, Kentucky Power cited the Commission's November 14, 2018 Order that, among other things, amended the March 16, 2018 Order to grant Kentucky Power a CPCN to construct the Hazard-Jackson 69 kV reconfiguration, and provided guidance that Kentucky Power could initiate a future proceeding regarding the proposed Supplemental Projects. Kentucky Power stated that it intended to file a new application regarding the Supplemental Projects in the near future.

Based upon the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power established good cause to cancel the November 27, 2018

hearing and to dismiss this proceeding without prejudice, and therefore Kentucky Power's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kentucky Power's motion to cancel the November 27, 2018 hearing is granted.

- 2. Kentucky Power's motion to dismiss this matter without prejudice is granted.
- 3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
