ORDER

On May 15, 2018, Dawson Springs City Water and Sewer (Dawson Springs) filed with the Commission a revised tariff sheet setting forth a proposed adjustment to its existing rate for wholesale water service to South Hopkins Water District (South Hopkins), to be effective June 26, 2018. Also on May 15, 2018, South Hopkins objected to the proposed wholesale rate increase. Finding further proceedings necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rate adjustment, the Commission entered an Order on June 15, 2018, suspending the proposed rate, making South Hopkins a party to this proceeding, and establishing an intervention deadline of July 10, 2018. There were no requests for intervention. By Order entered on September 19, 2018, the Commission established a procedural schedule and issued requests for information to Dawson Springs.

On September 25, 2018, Dawson Springs filed a motion to withdraw its proposed wholesale rate increase and requesting that the Commission close this matter and remove it from its docket without prejudice.

Dawson Springs's motion explains that it "has been negotiating a new wholesale water purchase agreement with South Hopkins . . . during the past few months," which,

when finalized, “will contain a wholesale rate mutually agreed upon by both” Dawson Springs and South Hopkins.

South Hopkins, the only other party to this proceeding, did not object or respond to the motion within the timeframe established in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 5(2).

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Dawson Springs has established good cause to grant the request to withdraw its proposed wholesale rate increase and dismiss this case without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Dawson Springs’s motion to withdraw the proposed wholesale rate increase contained in its May 15, 2018 filing is granted.
2. This case is dismissed without prejudice.
3. This case is closed and removed from the Commission’s docket.
