ORDER

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 10, 2018, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) for the six-month period that ended on April 30, 2018. As part of this review the Commission held a formal hearing in this matter on October 9, 2018. On October 11, 2018, KU filed its response to Commission Staff's post-hearing data request.

A review of KU's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six-month period under review ranged from a low of \$.02431 per kWh in April 2018, to a high of \$.02823 per kWh in January 2018, with a six-month average of \$.02533 per kWh.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of KU's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

The charges and credits billed by KU through its FAC for the period
 November 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018, are approved.

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This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
