ORDER

Before the Commission are requests to intervene filed by Teresa Miller. Ms. Miller requests intervention in this matter and in Case No. 2018-00294,¹ involving Kentucky Utilities Company's (KU) rate application. Ms. Miller states that she opposes the request from Louisville Gas and Electric Company (LG&E) to increase rates. LG&E has filed a response objecting to the intervention request.

Having reviewed the request for intervention and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the only person entitled to intervene as a matter of right is the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Office of Rate Intervention (Attorney General), pursuant to KRS 367.150(8)(b). The Attorney General petitioned for full intervenor status in this case, noting in his motion that KRS 367.150(8) "grants him the right and obligation to appear before regulatory bodies of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to represent consumers' interests."² The Attorney General's

petition was granted by the Commission's Order dated October 15, 2018. Intervention by

all others is permissive and is within the sound discretion of the Commission.³

In exercising its discretion to determine permissive intervention, the Commission follows its regulation, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(11). That regulation requires a person seeking intervention to file a request stating that person's interest in the proceeding. That regulation further provides that:

The commission shall grant a person leave to intervene if the commission finds that he has made a timely motion for intervention and that he has a special interest in the case that is not otherwise adequately represented or that his intervention is likely to present issues or to develop facts that assist the commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.⁴

It is under these statutory and regulatory criteria that the Commission reviews a motion to intervene.

The Commission finds that Ms. Miller does not articulate a special interest in this proceeding, only a general interest that she shares in common with all other LG&E customers. In addition, Ms. Miller has not shown that she is likely to present issues or to develop facts that will assist the Commission in resolving this matter. Regarding Ms. Miller's status as utility customers of LG&E,⁵ the Commission finds that the Attorney General, pursuant to KRS 367.150(8), will duly represent the interests of all LG&E


customers in this matter. Because the requisites of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8), have not been satisfied, the Commission will deny Ms. Miller's request for intervention.

Ms. Miller will have ample opportunity to participate in this even though she is not granted intervenor status. Ms. Miller can review all public documents filed in this case and monitor the proceedings via the Commission's website. In addition, Ms. Miller may file comments as frequently as she chooses, and those comments will be entered into the record of this case. Finally, if a formal evidentiary hearing is held, Ms. Miller will be provided an opportunity to present any information that she wishes for the Commission's consideration in this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ms. Miller's request to intervene is denied.
