## ORDER

This matter arises on a petition filed on August 27, 2014, by Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 13, requesting that designated materials filed with the Commission be afforded confidential protection for five years.

In support of its petition, Kentucky Power states that public disclosure of the designated materials contained in Attachments 1 and 2 to its response to Commission Staff's Data Request 1–20 would result in competitive injury by revealing key pricing and business terms and potentially producing a chilling effect on the willingness of future bidders to submit responses to Kentucky Power coal-supply solicitations.

Having considered the petition and the materials at issue, the Commission finds that the time for which Kentucky Power requested confidential treatment has run, and therefore the August 27, 2014 petition is denied as moot.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

 Kentucky Power's August 27, 2014 petition for confidential protection is denied as moot.

- Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Kentucky Power shall file revised pages reflecting as unredacted the designated materials subject to the August 27, 2014 petition that has been denied confidential treatment.
- 3. The designated materials in the August 27, 2014 petition for which confidential protection was denied shall not be placed in the public record for 30 days following the date of this Order to allow Kentucky Power to seek any remedy afforded by law.
