Having determined that the hearing in this matter cannot be completed in one day as currently scheduled, the Commission finds, on its own motion, that the hearing should be rescheduled from May 14, 2019, to May 13, 2019, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time and be continued on May 14, 2019. The Commission further finds that, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, good cause exists to grant a deviation from the hearing notice requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2), and waive the requirement to republish the notice of the hearing. On April 22, 2019, Kentucky-American Water Company (Kentucky-American) filed evidence that it submitted a request to the Kentucky Press Service, Inc., to publish notice of the then-scheduled hearing date of May 14, 2019, once in each newspaper in Kentucky-American's 14-county service territory beginning on April 23. 2019. Due to publication schedules, it is likely that renotice would not be published prior to the rescheduled May 13, 2019 hearing date. The hearing notice informs Kentucky-American's customers of the opportunity to make a public comment on this proceeding at 9 a.m. on May 14, 2019. Because the opportunity for public comment remains as scheduled, no person who wants to make a public comment will be prejudiced.¹

¹ In addition to the opportunity to file written comments at any time this matter is pending, a Public Comment Hearing is scheduled for May 6, 2019, in Kentucky-American's service territory.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
