ORDER

This matter arises from Citipower, LLC's (Citipower) application to adjust its rates pursuant to the procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:076, for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to acquire an existing pipeline, and for authority to obtain financing to acquire the existing pipeline. On July 2, 2019, Citipower filed a motion requesting that it be permitted to use the electronic filing procedures established by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, in this matter, arguing that the electronic filing procedures would be more cost effective and that no person would be adversely affected since none have intervened.

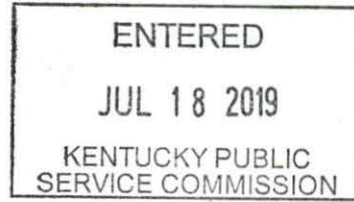
The Commission finds Citipower's arguments in this matter persuasive. The Commission notes that it is still early in the case, and no party requested to intervene by the deadline. Converting this matter to an electronic case should not impose a significant burden. Thus, having reviewed the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Citipower's motion to convert this matter to an electronic filing case should be granted.

The Commission notes that the procedural order in this matter required that the initial request for information to Citipower be filed by July 8, 2019, and answered by July 22, 2019. Because of an administrative issue on the afternoon of July 8, 2019, Commission Staff's request for information was not posted and served until the morning of July 9, 2019. Due to this delay, the Commission finds that the procedural schedule should be amended to grant Citipower until July 23, 2019, to respond to initial requests for information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDER THAT:

1. Citipower's motion to convert this matter to an electronic case is hereby granted;
2. Filings in this matter shall be made and processed pursuant to the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, from the date this Order is entered;
3. Initial requests for information to Citipower filed on or before July 9, 2019, shall be deemed timely;
4. Citipower shall have until July 23, 2019, to file responses to initial requests for information;
5. The Commission's July 1, 2019 Order in this matter is amended and vacated to the extent that it conflicts with paragraph numbers 1 through 4 herein; and
6. All other provisions of the Commission's prior orders in this case shall remain in full force and effect.
