ORDER

On August 9, 2019, McCreary County Water District (McCreary District) submitted tariff filings to amend its water and sewer tariffs.<sup>1</sup> McCreary District proposed to revise its sewer tariff to add an industrial pre-treatment program and to update its general rules for sewer service. McCreary District proposed to revise its water tariff to update its rules regarding the discontinuance of water service and to implement a cross-connection policy. McCreary District requested in both filings that the 30 days' notice period be shortened to 20 days pursuant to KRS 278.180(1).

The primary reason for McCreary District's tariff filings is to provide service to a new customer, Fibrotex USA, Inc. (Fibrotex USA), which will be manufacturing an ultra-lightweight camouflage net system for the Department of Defense. The production processes used by Fibrotex USA will require that its wastewater be pre-treated before being discharged into McCreary District's sewer system. In order for Fibrotex USA to be in compliance with its contract with the Department of Defense, it must begin production no later than September 1, 2019.

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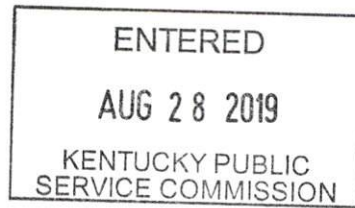

KRS 278.180(1) permits the Commission to shorten the 30 days' notice period to 20 days upon a showing of good cause. The Commission finds that McCreary District's need to provide service to Fibrotex USA by September 1, 2019, establishes good cause to shorten the notice period to 20 days. Notice of the revisions was given to customers via publication in the McCreary County Voice. The first notice was published on August 8, 2019, and the next two notices were set to appear in the August 15, 2019, and August 22, 2019, editions of the McCreary County Voice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. McCreary District's request that the notice period for its revised tariffs be shortened to 20 days is approved.
2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
