ORDER

On May 1, 2020, Clark Energy Cooperative, Inc., pursuant to the amended “streamlined procedure” established in Case No. 2018-00407,<sup>1</sup> filed an application seeking a general adjustment in its rates. Under the procedure established in Case No. 2018-00407,<sup>2</sup> the Commission, upon receipt of an application, is to issue an Order that, *inter alia*, grants the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, through the Office of Rate Intervention (Attorney General), intervention in the case and establishes a deadline for the filing of comments in the record regarding whether the application should be processed under the streamlined procedure. On May 4, 2020, the Attorney General filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding.

Based upon the motion and the procedures established for streamlined proceedings, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The Attorney General is granted intervention in this proceeding.

2. The Attorney General shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties after the date of this Order.

3. The Attorney General shall comply with all provisions of the Commission's regulations, 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, related to the service and electronic filing of documents.

4. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(9), within seven days of entry of this Order, the Attorney General shall file a written statement with the Commission that:

a. Certifies that it, or its agent, possesses the facilities to receive electronic transmissions; and

b. Sets forth the electronic mail address to which all electronic notices and messages related to this proceeding should be served.

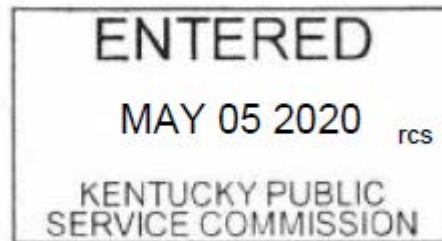
5. Any comments regarding whether this application should be processed under the streamlined procedure shall be filed within seven days of the date of this Order.

6. The Commission directs the Attorney General to the Commission's March 16, 2020 and March 24, 2020 Orders in Case No. 2020-00085<sup>3</sup> regarding filings with the Commission. The Commission expects the original documents to be filed with the Commission within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency.
