ORDER

On November 10, 2020, Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) filed a motion requesting to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(1)(b)(2), which requires newspaper publication of notice of a hearing not less than seven days prior to the hearing.

As a basis for the motion, Kentucky Power stated that it timely provided notice to Kentucky Press Service, Inc. with sufficient time for publication of timely notice in each of the 20 counties in Kentucky Power's service territory. Kentucky Power explained that all but two of the newspapers published notice on or before November 6, 2020. Kentucky Power further explained that *The Licking Valley Courier*, in Morgan County, Kentucky, and *The Elliot County News*, Elliot County, Kentucky, failed to publish the notice as scheduled. *The Licking Valley Courier* will publish the notice on November 12, 2020, and *The Elliot County News* will publish the notice on November 13, 2020. Kentucky Power asserted that it acted in good faith, timely provided notice to Kentucky Press Service, Inc., and the delay in publishing notice was outside of Kentucky Power's control. Kentucky

Power argued that the deviation will not prejudice the public or the Commission because notice of the hearing will be published prior to the hearing.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Kentucky Power filed evidence that established good cause to grant the requested deviation. In addition to the motion, Kentucky Power filed notice of proof of publication on November 10, 2020, for the newspapers that timely published the notice between November 2 and November 5, 2020. On November 9, 2020, Kentucky Power filed notice of email communications with Kentucky Press Service, Inc. dated October 26 and October 27, 2020, arranging for publication. The above evidence demonstrates that Kentucky Power undertook timely action for publication of the notice and that all but two of the newspapers actually published the notice within the regulatory timeframe. Additionally, notice will be filed on November 12 and November 13, 2020, for the hearing, which begins on November 17, 2020. Thus, the affected customers in Morgan and Elliot Counties are not unduly prejudiced because they will receive notice prior to the date of the hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky Power's motion requesting to deviate from filing requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(1)(b)(2), is granted.
