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## <u>order</u>

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, the Commission established this case on August 19, 2020, to review and evaluate the operation of the Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC) of Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Kentucky) for the six months that ended on April 30, 2020. As part of this review, Duke Kentucky responded to two requests for information.

A review of Duke Kentucky's monthly FAC filings shows that the fuel cost billed for the six months under review ranged from a low of \$0.022177 per kWh in December 2019 to a high of \$0.036591 per kWh in November 2019 with a six-month average of \$0.026164 per kWh.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds no evidence of improper calculation or application of Duke Kentucky's FAC charges or improper fuel procurement practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The charges and credits billed by Duke Kentucky through its FAC from November 1, 2019, through April 30, 2020, are approved.

2. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
