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#### <u>ORDER</u>

The Commission, on its own motion, finds that a procedural schedule should be established to review the reasonableness of the Tariffs Net Metering Service I and II proposed by Kentucky Power. The procedural schedule is attached as an Appendix to this Order.

The Commission further finds that a hearing in this matter should be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, and continuing through Wednesday, April 7, 2021, and Thursday, April 8, 2021, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, a videoconference hearing will be held, but the Commission reserves the right to hold an in-person hearing as circumstances warrant. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The procedural schedule set forth in the Appendix to this Order shall be followed.

2. A videoconference hearing in this matter shall be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021, at 9 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time, and continuing through Wednesday, April 7, 2021, and Thursday, April 8, 2021, in the Richard Raff Hearing Room at the offices of the Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.

3. Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky Power) shall give notice of the hearing in compliance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(2)(b). In addition, the notice of hearing shall include the following statements: "This hearing will be streamed live and may be viewed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov"; and "Public comments may be made at the beginning of the hearing. Those wishing to make oral public comments may do so by following the instructions listed on the PSC website, psc.ky.gov." At the time the notice is mailed or publication is requested, Kentucky Power shall forward a duplicate of the notice and request to the Commission.

4. Pursuant to KRS 278.360 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(9), a digital video transcript shall be made of the hearing.

5. Commission Staff shall contact parties to provide information for participating in the videoconference hearing.
