COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO KENERGY CORP.

Kenergy Corp. (Kenergy), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission an electronic version of the following information. The information requested herein is due on June 11, 2021. Pursuant to the Commission's Orders in Case No. 2020-00085, issued March 16, 2020, and March 24, 2020, Kenergy SHALL NOT FILE the original paper copy of all requested information at this time, but rather shall file original paper copies within 30 days of the lifting of the current state of emergency. All responses in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Electronic documents shall be in portable document format (PDF), shall be searchable, and shall be appropriately bookmarked.

Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided. Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or

association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or the person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Kenergy shall make timely amendment to any prior response if Kenergy obtains information that indicates the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which Kenergy fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, Kenergy shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention shall be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a paper containing personal information, Kenergy shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

- a. Refer to Kenergy's Response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information (Staff's First Request), Item 3a. Explain why Kenergy is including language regarding self-read meters if there are no self-read meters.

b. Explain when a remote special meter would not occur and instead a

trip would occur.

c. Explain whether Kenergy is willing to clarify the difference in cost

between a Special Meter Reading Charge and a Remote Meter Reading Charge to the

customer when one is requested.

2. Refer to the Application, Exhibit 2, Fifth Revised Sheet No. 32. Explain why

a seasonal or temporary service turn-on charge cannot be handled remotely.

3. Refer to the Application, Exhibit 2, Third Revised Sheet No. 32 (Exh. B)

and Kenergy's Response to Staff's First Request, Item 3d. If all meters are AMI, explain

why Turn-On, terminations, disconnects, and reconnects are not handled remotely.

4. Refer to Kenergy's Response to Staff's First Request, Item 22. Provide an

update.
